Energy Efficiency Outreach

- Developing and implementing a comprehensive community-based outreach strategy
- Engaging community organizations and other partners
- Representing Mass Energy in collaborative outreach efforts
- Implementing direct outreach tactics, such as hosting events, giving presentations, maintaining social media, etc.

Program Administration

- Analyzing program performance and trends to inform program design and local and state advocacy
- Tracking and reporting for internal, partner, and funder use
- Completing other general program support tasks as assigned

Required qualifications:

- Strong written and verbal communication skills, including public speaking
- MS Office skills, including Word, Excel, and PowerPoint are required, and experience with other databases is favorable, especially SalesForce
- Ability to travel occasionally within Massachusetts and work on nights and weekends
