Directors of nonprofit charitable organizations have fiduciary duties of due care and loyalty to the organization they serve.

# DUTY OF DUE CARE

### Due Care =

#### **Ensuring mission is carried out overtime**

- Careful board process and procedure
  - Bylaws with board qualifications and term limits
- Engagement, deliberation and action
  - Regular meeting procedures and record of action
- Strategic planning
