Please be as specific as possible when completing the nomination and be sure to highlight why the nominee is uniquely qualified for this award. Nominations will effectively convey the following criteria about how the organization:

- 1. Identified a clear and compelling need in the local community/nonprofit sector
- 2. Created and implemented an effective and timely campaign to achieve goal(s)
- 3. Used effective messaging and tools to engage constituents, the general public, and/or public policy decision makers in a meaningful way throughout the advocacy process
- 4. Achieved meaningful and measurable outcomes by accomplishing goals

Deadline: The deadline for all nominations is Friday, March 18. 2016.
