The Excellence Award in Innovation recognizes a nonprofit organization that has utilized new models, solutions or strategies to adapt to a changing environment and/or to find new ways of solving problems faced by the organization or the populations it serves.

<u>Please be as specific as possible when completing the nomination and be sure to highlight</u> why the nominee is uniquely qualified for this award. Nominations will effectively convey the following criteria about how the organization:

- 1. Identified a compelling need or challenge that existed internally or in the local community
- 2. Created and implemented an innovative model, solution, or strategy to address the identified need
- 3. Used new and creative tools and approaches to successfully achieve goal(s) in ways different more conventional approaches
- 4. Achieved meaningful and measureable outcomes with a plan for continued sustainability of new model, solution or strategy

Deadline: The deadline for all nominations is Tuesday, March 18, 2016.
