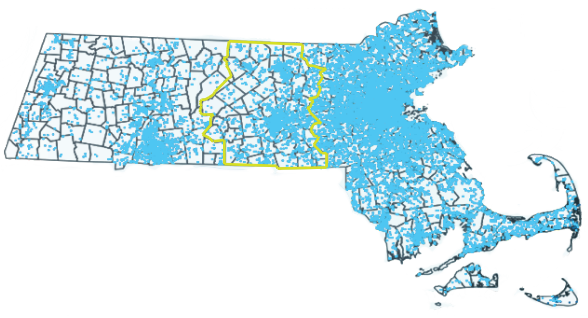

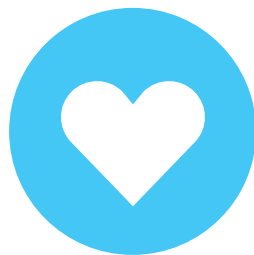

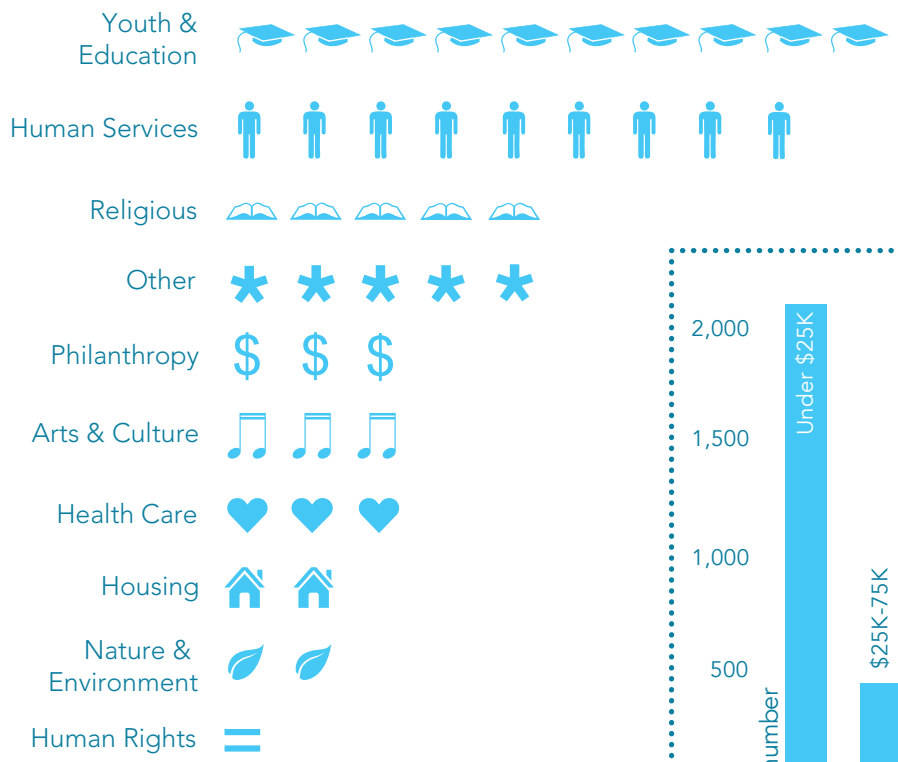

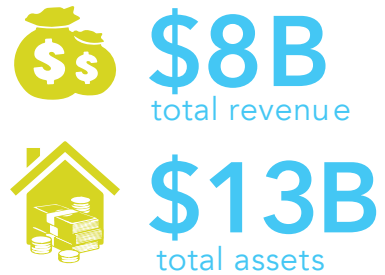

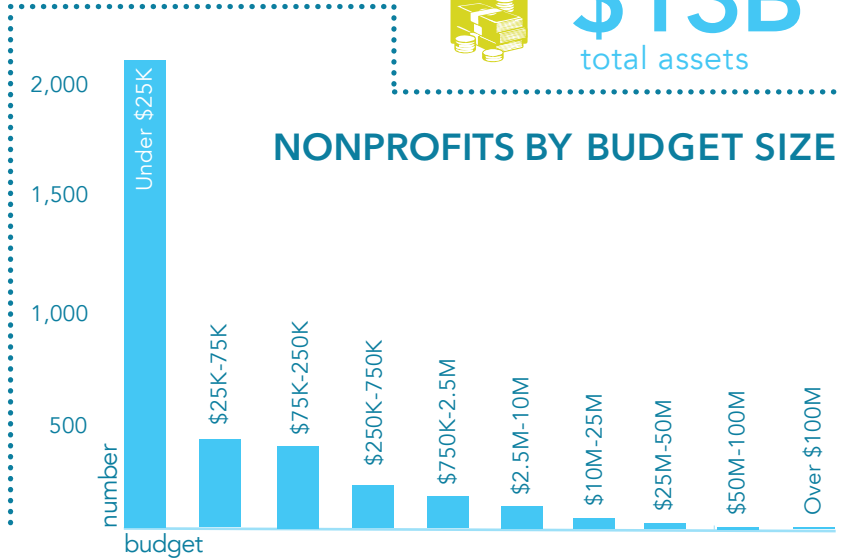
NONPROFITS BY SUBSECTOR [1 symbol ≈ 80 organizations]
