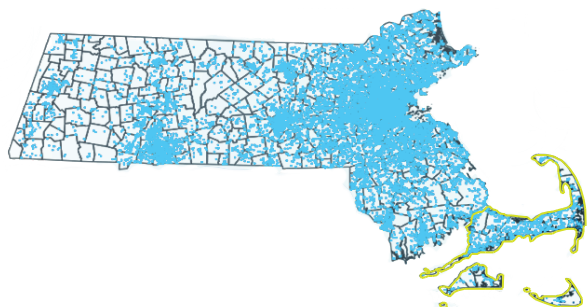

The Cape & Islands' Environment & Nature sector includes 164 nonprofits, representing **\$356.5 MILLION** in revenue.

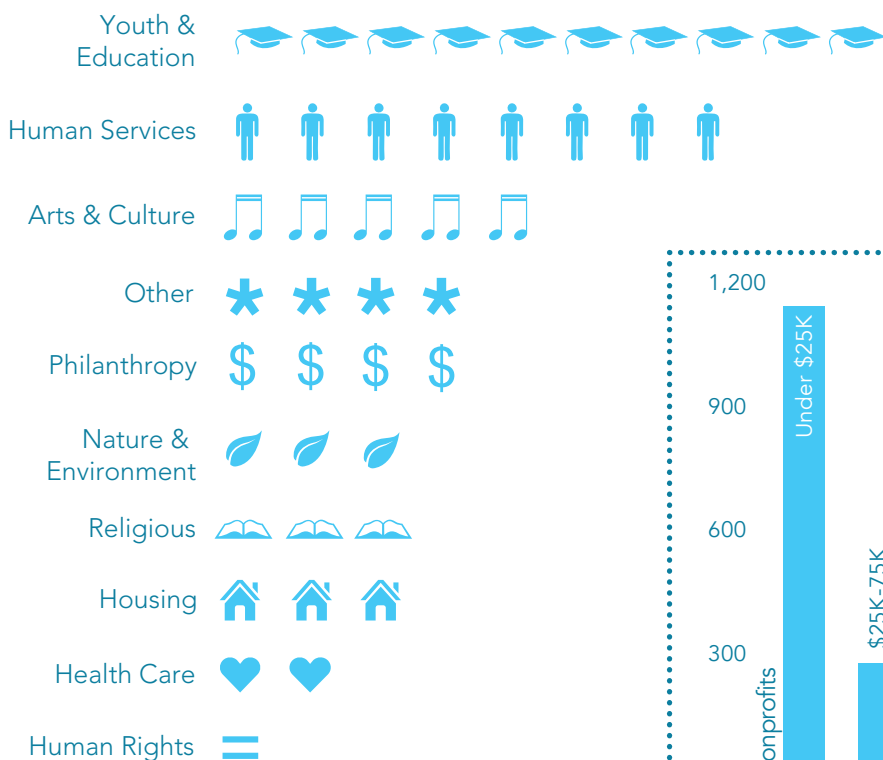


## ARTS & CULTURE

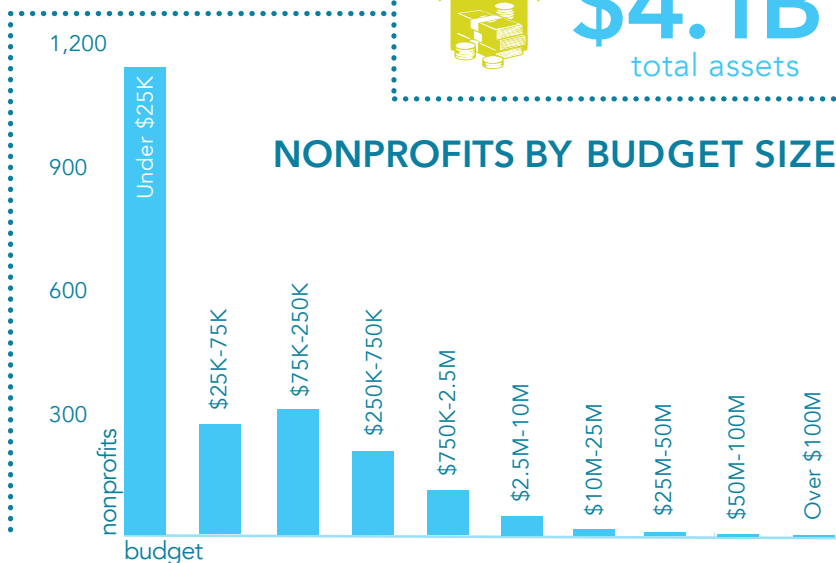
