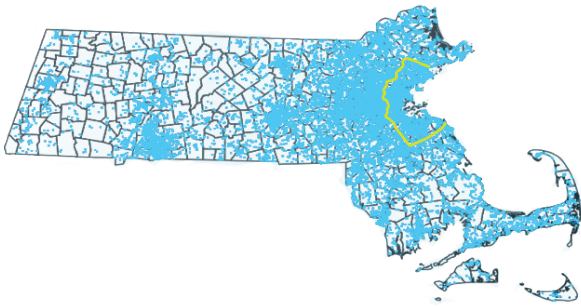

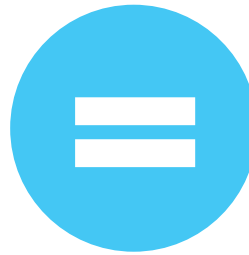

is Greater Boston's largest subsector, representing over 2,000 organizations.

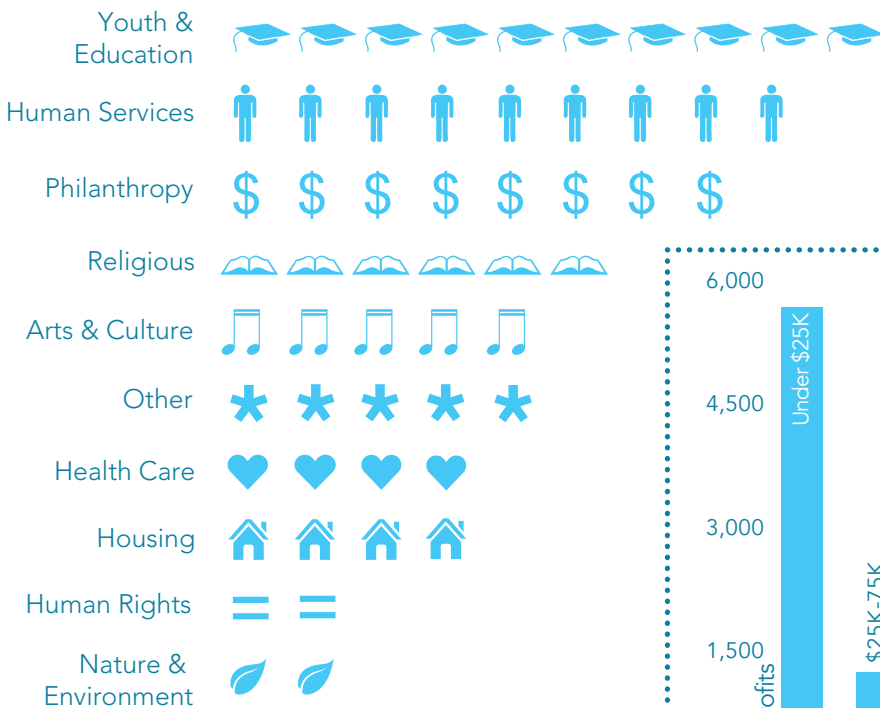


HUMAN RIGHTS

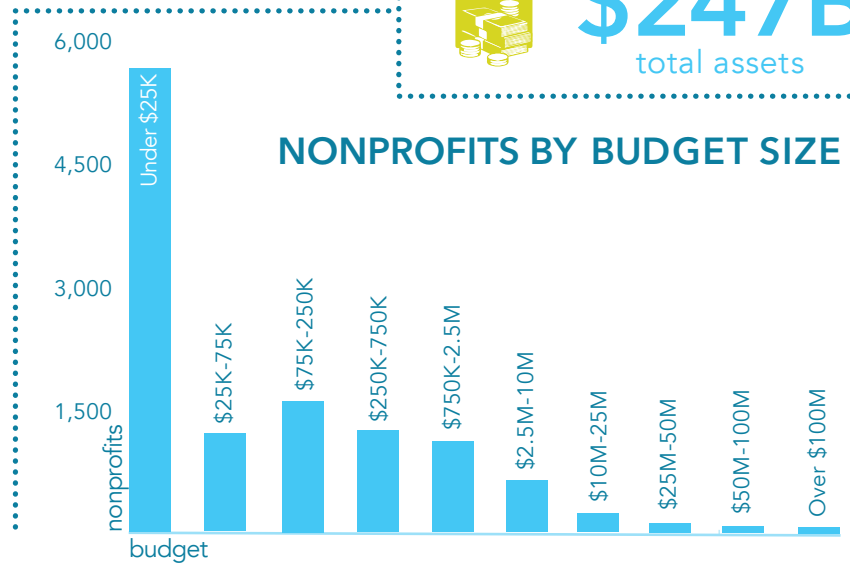
